Name of the project: GeoGate

The aim of the project: Creation of a visitation point, unique in the country, in the village of Sătuc, which will be the gateway to all the points of interest in the area included in the Geopark Ținutul Buzăului.

Partners: Intercommunity Development Association Ținutul Buzăului in partnership with Buzău County Council, Mayoralty of Berca commune

Project implementation date: 2019

Budget: 15,000 euro

Granted by: Buzău County Council

Context: The Buzăului Valley is the main tourist area of the county from the Curvature-Carpathian, where you can easily reach the Mud Volcanoes, the Live Fires, the Măgura Sculpture Camp and further, the Colți Amber Museum and the religious cave settlements of Aluniș and Bozioru villages.

The modern tourist information point will be set up in a building on the side of DN10 Buzău – Brașov, in the Sătuc village, at the crossroad with Berca, where a school and a kindergarten operated, closed in the meantime because of lack of children/pupils.
